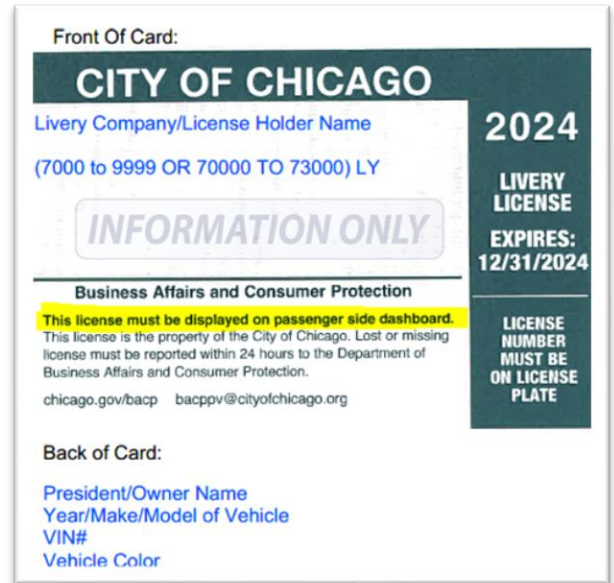

LIVERY VEHICLE LICENSE “HARD” CARD DISPLAY REMINDER

The 2024 Livery Vehicle License “Hard” Card must be displayed on the passenger-side of vehicle dashboard.

Failure to display the livery vehicle license “hard” card on the passenger-side of vehicle dashboard while in operation is a violation of Municipal Code of Chicago (MCC) ordinance section 9-114-140, titled “License card”.

The minimum fine for failing to display the livery vehicle license “hard” card as directed by BACP is \$100 per violation.



Please note that BACP eliminated the windshield livery vehicle license sticker.

Additional Important BACP Reminders:

- (1) Livery vehicle owners and livery chauffeurs may not operate on expired licenses. Livery vehicle licenses which have not been renewed for the January 1, 2024 – December 31, 2024, license terms MAY NOT OPERATE!
