governed by the Dept of Environment, Dept of Public

provisions affecting Scrap Processors is not applicable to

Auto Parts Recyclers for the following reasons;

The Illinois Auto Parts Recycler defines this as ,

Auto Parts Recycler- A person in the business of acquiring

previously owned vehicles and vehicle parts in a manner

other than that described in the definition of Scrap

Processor.

• we purchase vehicles and dismantle them , sell and

store parts for resale

• we then sell the remaining vehicle hulk to the Scrap

We abide by the permit granted us by the City of Chicago
and license by the State of Illinois and we would like to
licensed as a Auto Part Recycler and not a Scrap Processor.

Scrap Processor-A person who purchases any material
that may have been a vehicle or essential part for
processing in to a form other than a vehicle or essential
part for remelting purposes only. No Scrap Processor may
sell a vehicle or essential part as such, unless licensed to

Chicago

- we don't buy or sell ferrous or non-ferrous metals
- at most we sell a few loads of vehicle hulks to the Scrap processor a month, so we don't have trucks constantly in and out of hauling vehicle hulks as to not create dust and or noise pollution.
- we don't have a crusher or a shredder therefore again no dust or noise pollution
- we keep our yard clean as required by the City of Chicago
