**ORDER**

On February 5, 2014, the Superintendent of Police filed with the Police Board of the City of Chicago charges against Lieutenant Edward Richards, Star No. 240 (hereinafter referred to as “Respondent”), recommending that the Respondent be discharged from the Chicago Police Department for violating several Rules of Conduct.

On March 14, 2014, the Superintendent moved to withdraw the charges against the Respondent without prejudice because the Respondent resigned his position with the Chicago Police Department. The Police Board has considered the Superintendent’s motion.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Superintendent’s motion is **granted**.
