

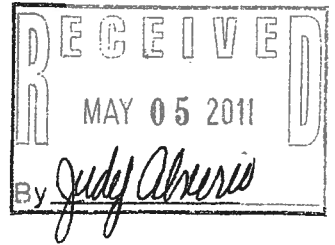

On 4/20/11, DPS authorized DWM to solicit bids for an emergency contract for Rental and Replacement of Traffic Control Devices. On 4/22/11, DWM searched the City of Chicago's MBE/WBE directory (see attached). Based on our search, there were no MBE/WBE firms that provided rental of DWM's required of traffic control devices. Therefore, DWM solicited bids from the following vendors:

- Traffic Control & Protection Inc.
- RoadSafe Traffic Systems Inc.
- Barricade Lites, Inc.
- Work Area Protection
- Highway Safety Corp.

On 4/27/11, four responses were received thru the Bid and Bond Room, one from Work Area Protection who indicated that they were only a manufacturer of equipment and the other three from Barricade Lites, Inc., Traffic Control & Protection Inc. and Highway Safety Corp. Based on our review, Barricade Lites, Inc. prices including their hourly labor rates were substantially higher. Both Traffic Control & Protection and Highway Safety individual prices varied for particular line items, but Highway Safety's hourly labor rate was approximately 16.5% lower than Traffic Control Protection. Due to the nature of these services and past expenditures, the hourly labor rates make up a substantial cost for these services. Therefore, DWM recommends that the emergency contract be awarded to Highway Safety Corp. Also, based on ongoing construction projects/operations, DWM cannot identify a total price of award but can indicate that DWM's monthly estimated expenditures average

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between \$130 – 160k/month. Based on this estimated monthly cost, DWM would request that this emergency contract be awarded for the \$250,000 limit.



Subject: Request for Emergency Authorization (RX 58978)
Rental and Replacement of Traffic Control Devices

The Department of Water Management (DWM) is requesting an emergency contract in the amount of \$250,000 for Rental and Replacement of Traffic Control Devices. Although, the lead department is the Department of Transportation, DWM utilizes this contract extensively for the rental of traffic control devices for all construction sites and at various other DWM locations. This emergency contract is needed in order to maintain safety control and compliance with the State of Illinois, Uniform Traffic Control Systems for Construction and Maintenance Operations.

The initial PO # 4339 with Highway Safety Corporation expired on July 31, 2010. Prior to expiration, DWM was advised to enter a super release to cover a period of six (6) months or until the re-advertisement of a new contract award. However, at this time, the super release for \$1M has been exhausted and no contract is currently in place for these services. The original specification request for a new 5 year contract was sent to DPS on 11/20/2009 (Req. 43758) by the lead department, CDOT. DWM also submitted req. 44944 for participation on the new contract. Therefore, we would like to request your permission to solicit vendors for an emergency contract.
