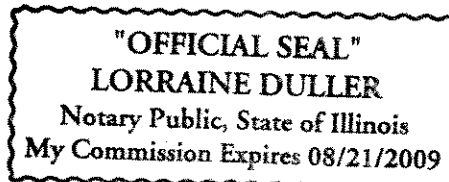

This Department is requesting that the Contractor install and inspect four nets that capture discharged debris from four Combined Sewer Outfall locations.

Work will include:

- Acquiring four nets for installation and sixteen nets as spares. The nets are typically damaged during storm events and require frequent replacement.
- Installation of four nets.
- One inspection of each net after first storm event that impacts the location of the individual net.

Estimated duration of this Project is (9) nine Months.
