The following information is provided in response to questions posed at our department's hearing on September 29, 2021, to discuss the proposed 2022 budget.

Alderman Burnett requested the cost of the state permit to trap raccoons.

Illinois Wildlife is protected by Illinois Compiled Statute and may only be removed by lawful means. Nuisance Animal Removal Permits may be issued for some species if it is determined that wildlife are causing property damage and/or a threat to human health and safety and reasonable attempts to mitigate conflict have been tried.

Most nuisance wildlife problems are the result of people feeding wildlife, either intentionally (bird feeders, corn for squirrels, etc.) or incidentally (leaving food out for pets, bird feeder spillage, etc.). It is important to recognize that people must do their part to discourage wildlife by non-lethal means before removing animals. Removing every raccoon, skunk, squirrel etc. from your property and/or neighborhood is neither practical nor supported. The link to request a permit is found below.

CACC's position count increased by three in 2022. Two Animal Care Aide I's and one Supervising Veterinarian.

The following information is provided in response to an emailed questionnaire from Alderman Ramirez-Rosa after the September 29, 2021 meeting regarding the proposed 2022 budget.

When was the last time CACC hired "externally" for a high-level managerial/administrative job or did a national search?

- Chicago Animal Care and Control works very closely with the Department of Human Resources to post positions. The last external management hire from CACC was a Deputy Director position filled in May of 2018, which hired an individual from the Department of Law. The last management hire using a candidate completely external from the City was the Executive Director position in May of 2016.

What is the amount of overtime (OT) actually used at CACC, and which employees use the most OT?

- CACC spent \$177,117 on overtime through July 31, 2021. Overtime is granted to represented employee who work on Holidays, cover for others on approved time off, court hearings, etc. The Animal Control Officer title earned the highest amount of overtime in 2021.

What qualifications do CACC staff have to work with animals?

- Qualifications for our various positions are listed on the job descriptions created by the Department of Human Resources.

How many are CVT (Certified Vet Technician), CPDT (Certified Professional Dog Trainer) or CDBC (Certified Dog Behavior Consultant) certified?

- CACC has 2 current Certified Veterinary Technicians and currently looking to hire one more. We do not have positions which require CPDT or CDBC certifications.

Who makes euthanasia decisions and how are staff qualified to make these decisions, especially for behavior?

- Euthanasia decisions are made by the Animal Shelter Manager and/or Veterinarians based on criteria set forth in Standard Operating Procedure General Order #027. The Order is on our website at the following link: https://www.chicago.gov/content/dam/city/depts/cacc/PDFFiles/GO_027_Euthanasia_of_Animals.pdf

Do you have veterinarians certified to care for small or exotic animals?

- CACC has 3 Veterinarians Licensed by the State of Illinois for the care of all animals.

How many registered volunteers does CACC have?

- Approximately 200

How many were active before Covid vs. now?

- Approximately 200

What is the CACC Advisory Commission?

- Per the Municipal Code of Chicago - Chapter 2-120-010/020 - The Commission shall function as an advisory body to the Mayor and to Chicago Animal Care and Control with regard to animal-related matters in the City of Chicago. The Commission shall have the duty to provide an annual report to the Executive Director of the Department that makes recommendations for the continual improvement of operations and live outcomes.

When has CACC sought its advice and integrated it into policies/practices prior to their execution?

- In 2020, CACC sought assistance from the Commission regarding specialized medical equipment.

How many animals were serviced at low cost vaccine clinics last year vs. prior years?

- In 2020 and prior years, CACC was able to service at least 100 animals per clinic. Beginning in 2021, CACC was able to increase those numbers by servicing around 200 animals per clinic.

Why can't vaccine clinics take place outside on CACC grounds or with appointment numbers?

- CACC works with community partners to perform vaccine clinics around Chicago in the communities. Doing this allows us to expand our reach to provide services to neighborhoods across the City.

Citizens will forgo rabies vaccines due to an inability to pay the city's \$50 license fee. Does CACC provide financial assistance or a payment plan?

- Although CACC requires the license when you get a rabies vaccine, we do allow residents to forgo the license if they can not pay for it at the time of the clinic. CACC does not have a payment plan or financial assistance for services.

Does CACC have a formal community outreach program (that ACOs or others use) to routinely engage the public?

- CACC attends various community and Ward meetings, and organizes adoption outreach events and educational outreach events when invited.

Are adoption, intake, clinic or volunteer forms available in Spanish? There have been reports of good, qualified adopters leaving CACC because the adoption contracts (they are required to sign) have not been translated into Spanish.

- CACC always accommodates visitors who do not speak English. We regularly use staff to translate. CACC is currently working with the Mayors Office on a Language Access Toolkit which will help enhance the efforts we are already making.

How do we know how CACC animals and their new families are doing? Are ACO's doing follow-up "wellness" checks for adoptions?

- CACC has a group of Staff and Volunteers who are following up with clients after the Adoption Process with phone calls and automated emails.

Does CACC have an emergency preparedness plan for animals, staff and the public?

- Yes. AIS has access to an emergency plan for our building.
